NARRATIVE

On Tuesday, November 16, 2010, at 1700 hrs, I, Officer Boyle, sqd 138, responded to a report of a man with a gun at the Planned Parenthood clinic, located at 1965 Ford Parkway. Dispatch reported the man had a gun under his coat and parked his vehicle, a red Ford pickup, MN plate [REDACTED] in the clinic parking lot and walked away from the truck, last seen W/B in the alley. *D's plate*

I arrived at the location and drove into the parking lot. As I pulled into the parking lot, the complainant, who is security for the clinic ran up to me saying the male had just left in the truck, then pointed to a red pickup that drove past E/B on Ford Parkway, saying that was it.

I exited the parking lot and notified dispatch the truck was E/B on Ford Parkway. I activated my emergency lights to get through traffic and to catch up to the truck. When I was approximately 1 block behind the truck, it quickly pulled to the side of the road and stopped, approximately 1 block west of Snelling Ave. A "high risk" stop was performed.

The driver and only occupant, later I/D as HACKBARTH, THOMAS MICHAEL, [REDACTED], 19255 EIDELWEISS ST, CEDAR, MN 55011, CELL: [REDACTED], was directed to step from the car and given directions to keep his hands up. I asked Hackbarth if he had a gun, he stated he did. As he turned around a gun holster could be seen on his right side, hanging below his jacket. Hackbarth was secured in handcuffs by assisting officers and the gun was secured. *dob*

Hackbarth stated he had a conceal and carry permit which was located. The permit [REDACTED] was issued from Anoka County and was valid until [REDACTED]. *# DM 138*

Hackbarth asked what was going on. I told him about the call made from the Planned Parenthood clinic regarding him parking in their lot and his gun was seen, which caused some alarm. Hackbarth explained he was not aware of where he parked. He explained he parked in the lot and walked into the alley trying to find his girlfriend. He stated it was a jealousy thing, and he wanted to check up on her. Hackbarth stated he thought she was at some cafe in the area. *End date DM Ms. 624.714*

Hackbarth stated his girlfriend's name was [REDACTED]. He stated he did not have a phone number for her, nor did he know where she lived. He stated he met her on a on-line dating service and only communicates with her through the website. He could not recall which on-line site it was. He stated [REDACTED] worked downtown St Paul, but did not know where. Hackbarth he has only known [REDACTED] for approximately 2 months, and they have only gone out a couple of times.

I was not able to make contact with [REDACTED] based on the limited information provided.

Hackbarth's truck had some maps and binoculars on the front seat. Some additional ammunition for he .357 revolver was under the seat.

Hackbarth was asked if he had been consuming any alcohol. He stated he had not. He willingly submitted to a PBT, which showed .000.

Sgt. Don Wilson came to the stop location. It was decided Hackbarth's gun would be recovered and turned

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into property, (Crime Lab). Hackbarth was cooperative and understanding regarding the decision to take his gun. Sgt. Wilson advised Hackbarth on who to call regarding his gun.

Hackbarth was given the related case number and released from the stop location.

Sqd 168, Officer J. Lee recovered the gun and turned it into the Crime Lab.

Sqd 190, Officer A. Reginek spoke to the complainant Worgens in further detail.

He said Paul Joseph Hackbarth was his brother who died about six years ago in Illinois during a robbery.

I transported the loaded handgun to HQ and turned it into CLL #33.

NARRATIVE

SQUAD 190 (A. REGINEK - SELBY AVE BEAT CAR) WENT TO THE AREA OF 1965 FORD PARKWAY (PLANNED PARENTHOOD) TO ASSIST SEVERAL OTHER WEST SQUADS ON A WEAPONS COMPLAINT.

UPON ARRIVAL I HEARD OVER THE AIR SQUAD 138 (J. BOYLE) HAD A SUSPECT STOPPED THAT MATCHED THE DESCRIPTION FROM THE CALLER AND WAS CODE 4. OFFICER BOYLE WAS WEST OF SNELLING ON FORD PARKWAY.

I THEN WENT TO THE ORIGINAL ADDRESS OF THE COMP AND ATTEMPTED TO GATHER INFORMATION.

I SPOKE WITH THE WITNESS I.D. AS LANDGREBE, NEIL ROSS [REDACTED] WHO TOLD ME THE FOLLOWING:

HE TOLD ME HE WAS THE SECURITY OFFICER WORKING AND OBSERVED A RED TRUCK PULL INTO THE PARKING LOT JUST WEST OF THE ADDRESS AND BACK INTO A SPACE. HE TOLD ME IT WAS SUSPICIOUS DUE TO THE [REDACTED] M DRIVER BACKED INTO THE SPACE AND ALSO THE BUSINESS WAS CLOSED FOR APPROXIMATELY 1 HOUR. HE OBSERVED THE [REDACTED] M, APPROXIMATELY 45-50 YOA GET OUT OF THE TRUCK AND REMOVE HIS DARK COLORED BLAZER SPORT COAT. HE THEN SAW THE [REDACTED] M HAD A GUN INSIDE OF A HOLSTER ON HIS HIP, AROUND HIS WAIST. HE THEN SAW THE MALE SWITCH COATS, NOW PUT ON A DARK COLORED NYLON WINTER JACKET. THE MALE THEN CLOSED THE TRUCK DOOR AND WALKED NORTH TO THE ALLEY AND THEN WEST DOWN THE ALLEY TOWARD CLEVELAND. LANDGREBE THEN PHONED THE POLICE DUE TO HE WAS IN FEAR THE MALE WAS GOING TO HARM SOMEONE.

LANDGREBE THEN OBSERVED THE MALE WALK EAST DOWN FORD PKWY ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE STREET, CROSSED FORD AND THEN RETURNED TO THE PARKING LOT AND THEN INTO HIS TRUCK. LANDGREBE TOLD ME THE /M THE QUICKLY DROVE OUT OF THE LOT AND THEN SAW A SPPD SQUAD CAR GET RIGHT BEHIND THE SUSPECT VEHICLE.

I HAD LANDGREBE GET INTO MY SQUAD AND DO A , "SHOW UP" OF THE SUSPECT. LANDGREBE WAS SITTING IN MY FRONT SEAT AND OFFICER J. LEE GOT THE SUSPECT OUT OF OFFICER J. BOYLES SQUAD. THE DISTANCE WAS APPROXIMATELY 50 FEET BETWEEN THE WITNESS AND THE SUSPECT. I SHINED MY TAKEDOWN AND SPOTLIGHT ON THE SUSPECT FOR LANDGREBE TO SEE. LANDGREBE IMMEDIATELY TOLD ME, "YEP, THAT'S THE GUY I SAW WITH THE GUN, AND THAT'S HIS TRUCK IN FRONT OF THE POLICE CAR."

I THEN DROVE LANDGREBE BACK TO PLANNED PARENTHOOD AND GAVE HIM MY CARD WITH THE CASE NUMBER. LANDGREBE TOLD ME THE BUSINESS HAS VIDEO SURVEILLANCE OF THE INCIDENT BUT HE WAS UNABLE TO GET THE FOOTAGE TO A DISK. HE SAID IT WOULD BE SAVED AND AVAILABLE AT A LATER TIME.

NARRATIVE

Sgt. Don Wilson of Western District monitored a radio call on 11/16/10 to 1965 Ford Parkway the Planned Parenthood facility. Caller was a security guard who observed a ^{Race} M exit a red Ford pickup which had parked in the facility lot. Caller told operators that the male had a gun in a holster on his waist and while the caller was on the phone he observed the male walk off West down the alley behind the facility. Due to past acts of violence including shootings at Planned Parenthood clinics across the country I responded to the call. While I was en route to the call squad 138 (Officer Boyle) advised dispatch that he was behind the truck which was now E/B on Ford Parkway. A 10-1 was called and the vehicle was stopped with the assistance of multiple squads West of Fairview. Shortly after the stop was made Officer called a "Code 4" indicating the scene was stable and secure.

On my arrival Officers had a male detained in a squad car. He was identified as Thomas Hackbarth, ^{ob} [redacted] of Cedar, MN. Officer informed me that Hackbarth had a permit to carry a pistol that was issued in Anoka County and that when stopped he did have a pistol in a holster on his waist. I was also told that he was a State Legislator who was currently in office.

Hackbarth explained to Officer Boyle and later to me that he was in the area looking for a "girlfriend" who he thought was with another man. He stated her name was [redacted]. When I later questioned him about the female he did not know where she lived, did not have a phone or other contact number for her and communicated with her strictly on line. I had Officer Boyle ask him what her e-mail address was and he did not know it and said he communicated with her through web sites. When asked which particular web site he was not sure and did not provide the names of any possible web sites he may have used to communicate with her. I asked Hackbarth if the female was married and he said he did not know. I asked if he was married and he said he is going through a divorce. I asked how they got together for dates and he said they met places and that he never picked her up at home or work and reiterated again that he did not / does not know where she lives or works except that she works "somewhere" in downtown St Paul. I asked if the female had made any police reports involving him and he said she had not. Hackbarth did admit to me that he was mad that she may be out with another man, and that he was jealous. When I asked him about the gun he said he always carries a gun.

I directed Officers to do record check on Hackbarth through RMS, BCA and NCIC. Officers did find a Paul Hackbarth as an alias for Thomas Hackbarth but it was later learned that was his brother who had been a criminal up until he was killed during a bank robbery in Illinois.

Due to Hackbarths stalking like behavior, his being armed with a pistol while seeking out a female he was mad and jealous over, parking in an out of the way place and lack of information on the female I told Officers that in spite of his having a permit we would not be returning his pistol to him tonight.

After hackbarth was removed from the squad I spoke with him about my concerns with his behavior and actions and that because of them I was going to err on the side of public safety and not return his pistol to him. Mr. Hackbarth admitted that it all looked bad and told me he did not have a problem with me having Officers turn in his gun for now. I gave Mr. Hackbarth my business card and instructed him to contact the Office of the Chief in regards to the return of his weapon. Mr. Hackbarth was released but unable to start his truck due to a dead battery. Officer on scene assisted his with a "jump start" for his truck before clearing the scene.

Planned Parenthood parking lot. The security guard had witnessed Hackbarth get out of the vehicle with a gun underneath his jacket.

When I got into the area, Officer Boyle/Squad 138 had located the vehicle heading east on Ford Parkway. Officer Boyle/Squad 138 and Officer Bohn/Squad 139 had the vehicle stopped when I arrived to assist them.

We conducted a high risk stop on the vehicle. At gunpoint we ordered Hackbarth out of his vehicle and had him walk slowly backwards to us. Hackbarth said he had a firearm on his person and had a permit for it.

Hackbarth walked back toward me where I took control of him and placed him in handcuffs. Hackbarth had a revolver style pistol in a holster on his right hip. I removed the gun from his person and gave it to Officer J. Lee/Squad 168, who secured it. Hackbarth said he had his drivers license and permit to carry in his wallet.

Hackbarth said he was a state legislator and was headed back to work. I asked Hackbarth why he parked in the Planned Parenthood parking lot and he said " I was looking for my girlfriend it was a stupid jealousy thing. I thought she was seeing a another guy and I was going to check on her. She was suppose to be at one of the shops over here, so I parked my truck and went to look for her car."

I placed Hackbarth in the rear of Officer Boyle's squad.

I asked Hackbarth if he had an alcoholic beverages to drink to today and he said he had a drink at the Downtowner early at around 1600 hours. Hackbarth submitted to a PBT, which showed a reading of .000 bac.

I Sgt. Payne was assigned to investigate this case. I reviewed the reports and done several checks on both Thomas Hackbarth and [REDACTED]. I discovered Hackbarth is a representative of the 48A district of the Minnesota House of Representatives. The reports written by the officers indicated Hackbarth had a permit to carry the firearm. Hackbarth had no criminal history on file. However, Thomas Hackbarth's name has been used in the past by his brother Paul Hackbarth who does have a criminal history.

Let it be noted that records indicate that Paul Hackbarth DOB/[REDACTED] is deceased as of 1-7-2003.

I Sgt. Payne also checked several sources to try and identify the female [REDACTED]. This is the person Hackbarth said he was checking up on prior to being stopped. I was unsuccessful in identifying [REDACTED].

On 11-18-10 I Sgt. Payne called and talked with Thomas Hackbarth. Hackbarth said he was checking to see if a female [REDACTED] he met on a singles-date line was being honest with him on where she was and what she was doing. He said he really liked her and they had gone out a few times for lunch and drinks. He said prior to being stopped he knew [REDACTED] was suppose to be meeting another person in the strip mall area off Ford Parkway. He said he parked his vehicle in an empty lot not knowing the lot belonged to Planned Parenthood. He said he parked got out took off his sport coat and put on his jacket. He then said he didn't see [REDACTED] and he got back into his vehicle and left. He then said he was stopped by police.

Hackbarth said he always carries the handgun because he has a permit to carry.

I explained to Hackbarth that this entire situation seemed a little odd and that he was border lining harassment or terroristic threats. He could not give me the females name or where she lived. He said he didn't know where she lived. He said he would just contact her through E-Mails. He met her on a date line but couldn't remember
